## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 5.001, Education Code, is amended by

- 9 (3-a) "Day treatment center" means a psychiatric day

  10 treatment facility, as defined by Section 1355.101, Insurance Code,
- 11 that does not provide residential services.

adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as follows:

- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 25, Education Code, is 13 amended by adding Section 25.0012 to read as follows:
- Sec. 25.0012. CHILDREN RECEIVING SERVICES AT DAY TREATMENT
- 15 CENTER. (a) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 16 shall provide educational services at a day treatment center to a
- 17 student enrolled in the district or charter school for whom:
- 18 <u>(1) a court orders the treatment; or</u>
- 19 (2) a psychiatrist or a licensed physician certified
- 20 by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology recommends the
- 21 treatment and specifies the recommended duration of the treatment
- 22 in a writing provided the district or charter school.
- 23 (b) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 24 shall maintain a copy of a writing received under Subsection

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- 1 (a)(2).
- 2 (c) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
- 3 contract for the provision of educational services to a student at a
- 4 day treatment center.
- 5 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.0551 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.0551. STUDENT RECEIVING EDUCATION SERVICES AT DAY
- 8 TREATMENT CENTER CONSIDERED FOR ACCOUNTABILITY PURPOSES. (a)
- 9 Except as provided by Subsection (b), a student receiving
- 10 educational services at a day treatment center in accordance with
- 11 Section 25.0012 is considered a student of the school district or
- 12 open-enrollment charter school that provides the services to the
- 13 student for purposes of determining the performance of a school
- 14 district, campus, or open-enrollment charter school under this
- 15 chapter, and the performance of such a student on an assessment
- 16 <u>instrument or other student achievement indicator adopted under</u>
- 17 Section 39.053 or reporting indicator adopted under Section 39.301
- 18 shall be determined, reported, and considered in the same manner as
- 19 the performance of other students enrolled in the district or
- 20 charter school.
- 21 (b) A student receiving educational services at a day
- 22 treatment center in accordance with Section 25.0012 is not
- 23 considered a student of a school district or open-enrollment
- 24 charter school for purposes of determining the performance of a
- 25 school district, campus, or open-enrollment charter school under
- 26 this chapter if the school district or charter school contracts for
- 27 the provision of services to that student, as permitted by Section

- 1 <u>25.0012(c).</u>
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 42.005, Education Code, is amended by
- 3 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 4 (h) For purposes of calculating average daily attendance, a
- 5 student receiving treatment at a day treatment center is considered
- 6 in attendance for each day for which a school district or
- 7 open-enrollment charter school provides educational services to
- 8 the student at the day treatment center, in accordance with Section
- 9 25.0012.
- SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
