A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the validity, reliability, and design of certain
- 3 state-adopted or state-developed assessment instruments for public
- 4 school students.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (a-11) and (a-12) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-11)</u> Subject to available appropriations, before an
- 9 assessment instrument adopted or developed under Subsection (a) may
- 10 be administered under that subsection, the assessment instrument
- 11 must, on the basis of empirical evidence, be determined to be valid
- 12 and reliable by a research institution that:
- 13 (1) has nationally recognized expertise in
- 14 determining validity and reliability of assessment instruments;
- 15 and
- 16 (2) is independent of the agency and of any other
- 17 entity that developed the assessment instrument.
- 18 <u>(a-12) The agency shall ensure that an assessment</u>
- 19 <u>instrument adopted or developed under Subsection (a) is designed</u>
- 20 only to assess student understanding of the essential knowledge and
- 21 skills identified by the State Board of Education under Section
- 22 28.002 of the subject and for the grade level for which the
- 23 assessment instrument is administered.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016

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- 1 school year.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
