- 2 relating to a maximum tuition rate under a fixed tuition price plan.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 54.017(h), to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 54.017. FIXED TUITION PRICE PLAN FOR UNDERGRADUATE
- 7 STUDENTS AT CERTAIN GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a)
- 8 In this section, "general academic teaching institution" and
- 9 "public state college" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 10 61.003.
- 11 (b) This section applies only to a general academic teaching
- 12 institution other than a public state college.
- 13 (c) The governing board of an institution to which this
- 14 section applies shall offer entering undergraduate students,
- 15 including undergraduate students who transfer to the institution,
- 16 the opportunity to participate in a fixed tuition price plan under
- 17 which the institution agrees not to increase tuition charges per
- 18 semester credit hour for a participating student for at least the
- 19 first 12 consecutive semesters that occur after the date of the
- 20 student's initial enrollment at any public or private institution
- 21 of higher education, regardless of whether the student enrolls at
- 22 any institution in those semesters, and subject to any restrictions
- 23 or qualifications adopted by the governing board. For purposes of
- 24 this section, one or more summer terms occurring in the same summer

- 1 is considered a semester.
- 2 (d) Unless the institution does not offer other tuition
- 3 payment options, an institution to which this section applies may
- 4 require an entering undergraduate student to accept or reject
- 5 participation in the fixed tuition price plan offered under this
- 6 section before the date of the student's initial enrollment at the
- 7 institution.
- 8 (e) This section does not require an institution to which
- 9 this section applies to offer a variable tuition price plan or other
- 10 tuition payment options to undergraduate students enrolled in the
- 11 institution.
- 12 (f) Fees charged by an institution to a student
- 13 participating in a fixed tuition price plan under this section may
- 14 not exceed the fees charged by the institution to a similarly
- 15 situated student who elects not to participate in the plan, if the
- 16 institution offers other tuition payment options. For purposes of
- 17 this subsection, students are similarly situated if they share the
- 18 same residency status, degree program, course load, course level,
- 19 and other circumstances affecting the fees charged to the students.
- 20 (g) This section does not apply to the tuition charged by an
- 21 institution to which this section applies to a student who enters
- 22 the institution for the first time before the 2014 fall semester.
- (h) The fixed tuition price plan under subsection (c) of an
- 24 institution not offering other tuition payment options may include
- 25 <u>a maximum tuition rate. Notwithstanding subsection (c), the</u>
- 26 <u>institution's tuition charges may vary between semesters during</u>
- 27 the period covered by the fixed tuition price plan, but the

- 1 <u>institution's tuition charges may not exceed the established</u>
- 2 maximum tuition rate.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
