3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 1601.353, Occupations Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	Sec. 1601.353. REQUIRED FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT. The
7	department may approve an application for a permit for a barber
8	school if the school meets health and safety standards established
9	by the department. The department shall not establish requirements
10	for square footage of floor space, a specific number of chairs, a
11	specific number of sinks, or other facility requirements not
12	related to health and safety. +
13	(1) is located in:
14	(A) a municipality with a population of more than
15	50,000 that has a building of permanent construction containing at
16	least 2,000 square feet of floor space, including classroom and
17	practical areas, covered in a hard-surface floor-covering of tile
18	or other suitable material; or
19	(B) a municipality with a population of 50,000 or
20	less or an unincorporated area of a county that has a building of
21	permanent construction containing at least 1,000 square feet of
22	floor space, including classroom and practical areas, covered in a
23	hard-surface floor-covering of tile or other suitable material;
24	(2) has the following equipment:

1	(A) at least 10 student workstations that include
2	a chair that reclines, a back bar, and a wall mirror;
3	(B) a sink behind every two workstations;
4	(C) adequate lighting for each room;
5	(D) at least 10 classroom chairs and other
6	materials necessary to teach the required subjects; and
7	(E) access to permanent restrooms and adequate
8	drinking fountain facilities; and
9	(3) meets any other requirement set by the commission.
10	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
