4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 202.019 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 202.019. REGULATION OF RESIDENTIAL LEASES. (a) A
8	property owners' association may not include or enforce a provision
9	in a dedicatory instrument that:
10	(1) imposes dues, a fee, a charge, an assessment, a
11	fine, a contribution, or another type of payment in connection with
12	the rental or leasing of a property owner's property;
13	(2) requires a tenant or rental applicant to be
14	reviewed or approved by the property owners' association; or
15	(3) <u>requires a property owner, tenant, or rental</u>
16	applicant, or that person's agent, to provide copies of documents
17	related to the rental or leasing of a property owner's property, in
18	violation of any applicable state or federal laws. In this
19	subsection, such documents include:
20	(A) <u>a lease;</u>
21	(B) <u>a lease or rental application; or</u>
22	(C) <u>a consumer or credit report.</u>
23	(b) A provision that violates Subsection (a) is void.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
