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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 2652.001, 2652.002, and 2652.006,
- 7 Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2652.001. LICENSE AND BOND OR DEPOSIT REQUIRED. An
- 9 individual may not act as an escrow officer unless the individual:
- 10 (1) holds a license issued by the department; [and]
- 11 (2) <u>is covered by</u> [maintains] a surety bond or deposit
- 12 required under Subchapter C; and
- 13 (3) is appointed under Section 2652.1511 as an escrow
- 14 officer by a title insurance agent or direct operation.
- 15 Sec. 2652.002. EMPLOYMENT OF ESCROW OFFICER. (a) A title
- 16 insurance agent or direct operation may not employ an individual as
- 17 an escrow officer unless the individual:
- 18 <u>(1)</u> holds a license <u>issued by the department;</u>
- 19 <u>(2) is covered by [and maintains</u>] a surety bond or
- 20 deposit as required under Subchapter C; and
- 21 (3) is appointed under Section 2652.1511 as an escrow
- 22 officer by the title insurance agent or direct operation [by this
- 23 chapter].
- 24 (b) A title insurance agent or direct operation may not

- 1 permit an individual to act as an escrow officer in this state
- 2 before the agent or direct operation has complied with Sections
- 3 2652.151 and 2652.1511 [2652.152] with respect to the individual.
- 4 Sec. 2652.006. RECORD OF ESCROW OFFICERS. The department
- 5 shall maintain a record of the name and address of each escrow
- 6 officer licensed by the department in a manner that ensures that the
- 7 escrow officers employed and appointed under Section 2652.1511 by
- 8 any title insurance agent or direct operation in this state may be
- 9 conveniently determined.
- SECTION 2. Section 2652.051(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (a) Before an initial license is issued to an individual to
- 13 act as an escrow officer in this state for a title insurance agent
- 14 or direct operation, the title insurance agent or direct operation
- 15 must file an application for an escrow officer's license and
- 16 appointment under Section 2652.1511 with the department on forms
- 17 provided by the department.
- SECTION 3. Section 2652.052(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (b) License fees, appointment fees, and renewal fees
- 21 collected under this chapter [Section 2652.152], shall be deposited
- 22 to the credit of the Texas Department of Insurance operating
- 23 account to be used by the department to enforce this chapter and any
- 24 other law of this state that regulates escrow officers for title
- 25 insurance agents or direct operations.
- SECTION 4. Sections 2652.055 and 2652.056, Insurance Code,
- 27 are amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 2652.055. LICENSE TERM. Unless a system of staggered
- 2 license renewal is adopted or required under Chapter 4003 [under
- 3 Section 4003.002], a license expires on the second June 1 following
- 4 the date of issuance.
- 5 Sec. 2652.056. PROCEDURE FOR LICENSE RENEWAL. An
- 6 individual may renew an unexpired escrow officer license by:
- 7 (1) submitting to the department on a form provided by
- 8 the department a completed application, signed and sworn by the
- 9 individual, stating that the applicant is an individual who is a
- 10 bona fide resident of this state or a state adjacent to this state;
- 11 and
- 12 (2) paying to the department a renewal fee in an amount
- 13 set by the department [AUTOMATIC TERMINATION OF LICENSE. The
- 14 license of each escrow officer employed by a title insurance agent
- 15 or direct operation that surrenders its license or has its license
- 16 revoked by the department is automatically terminated without
- 17 notice].
- 18 SECTION 5. Section 2652.101(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) A title insurance agent or direct operation shall
- 21 obtain, at its own expense, a bond for its escrow officers appointed
- 22 under Section 2652.1511 payable to the department. The bond shall
- 23 obligate the principal and surety to pay for any pecuniary loss
- 24 sustained by the title insurance agent or direct operation through
- 25 an act of fraud, dishonesty, forgery, theft, embezzlement, or
- 26 wilful misapplication by an escrow officer, either directly and
- 27 alone or in conspiracy with another person.

- 1 SECTION 6. Section 2652.151(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (a) A title insurance agent or direct operation shall
- 4 certify to the department, not later than the expiration date of the
- 5 title insurance agent's or direct operation's license, the name and
- 6 address of each individual employed and appointed under Section
- 7 <u>2652.1511</u> by the title insurance agent or direct operation to serve
- 8 as an escrow officer in this state.
- 9 SECTION 7. Subchapter D, Chapter 2652, Insurance Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 2652.1511 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2652.1511. APPOINTMENT OF ESCROW OFFICER. (a) An
- 12 <u>escrow officer may be employed and appointed by more than one title</u>
- 13 insurance agent or direct operation.
- 14 (b) Before an escrow officer may act in that capacity for a
- 15 title insurance agent or direct operation, the title insurance
- 16 agent or direct operation must appoint the escrow officer and file
- 17 the escrow officer's appointment with the department on a form
- 18 provided by the department.
- 19 <u>(c)</u> The appointment form must:
- 20 (1) be accompanied by a nonrefundable appointment fee;
- 21 (2) certify that the escrow officer is a bona fide
- 22 employee of a title insurance agent or direct operation with an
- 23 office in this state;
- 24 (3) be signed and sworn to by the title insurance agent
- 25 or direct operation and by the escrow officer; and
- 26 (4) demonstrate that the escrow officer is covered by
- 27 a surety bond or deposit required under Subchapter C.

- 1 (d) The appointment of the escrow officer expires on the
- 2 revocation, termination, or nonrenewal of the escrow officer's
- 3 license or termination of the escrow officer's employment with the
- 4 title insurance agent or direct operation that made the
- 5 appointment.
- 6 SECTION 8. Section 2652.153, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2652.153. NOTICE OF TERMINATION. A title insurance
- 9 agent or direct operation that terminates the employment of a
- 10 licensed escrow officer shall:
- 11 (1) immediately notify the department in writing of
- 12 the termination and request cancellation of the appointment under
- 13 Section 2652.1511 [license]; and
- 14 (2) notify the escrow officer of the action by the
- 15 title insurance agent or direct operation.
- SECTION 9. Sections 2652.203(a) and (d), Insurance Code,
- 17 are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The department shall notify a license holder of a
- 19 disciplinary action or enforcement action against the license
- 20 holder not later than the 30th business day after the date the
- 21 department assigns a file number to the action, except that this
- 22 subsection does not apply to a file or action:
- 23 (1) that is the subject of a pending criminal
- 24 investigation or prosecution; or
- 25 (2) about which the [deputy commissioner of the title
- 26 division of the] department makes a good faith determination that
- 27 there is a credible suspicion that there are ongoing or continuing

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- 1 acts of fraud by a person who is the subject of the action.
- 2 (d) The department may provide information about an
- 3 enforcement action, including a copy of a notice issued under this
- 4 section, to each title insurance agent or direct operation with
- 5 which an escrow officer has, or proposes to obtain, an appointment
- 6 under Section 2652.1511 [employment].
- 7 SECTION 10. Sections 2652.057(b) and 2652.152, Insurance
- 8 Code, are repealed.
- 9 SECTION 11. The changes in law made by this Act apply only
- 10 to the issuance or renewal of the license of an escrow officer on or
- 11 after January 1, 2016. The issuance or renewal of a license before
- 12 January 1, 2016, is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 13 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 14 effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
