- 2 relating to a study on the effectiveness of regulations governing
- 3 the design and construction of certain Type I municipal solid waste
- 4 landfills overlying aquifers.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
- 8 Environmental Quality.
- 9 (2) "Landfill" means a Type I municipal solid waste
- 10 landfill:
- 11 (A) the entirety of which was designed and
- 12 constructed in accordance with regulatory standards effective on or
- 13 after October 9, 1993; and
- 14 (B) that is not adjacent to a landfill that was
- 15 designed and constructed in accordance with regulatory standards
- 16 effective before October 9, 1993.
- 17 (b) The commission shall conduct a study to determine the
- 18 effectiveness of the regulations governing the design and
- 19 construction of landfills located over aquifers in this state. The
- 20 study must:
- 21 (1) determine whether landfills located over aquifers
- 22 are leaking;
- 23 (2) based on a review of groundwater monitoring data
- 24 collected and reported by statewide landfill operators and any

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- 1 other relevant information, determine if any leakage from landfills
- 2 built over aquifers has seeped into or contaminated the groundwater
- 3 underlying the landfills;
- 4 (3) include any recommendations necessary for
- 5 improving the effectiveness of the regulations governing the design
- 6 and construction of landfills located over aquifers, including
- 7 recommendations to:
- 8 (A) prevent or reduce leakage from landfills
- 9 overlying aquifers; and
- 10 (B) protect aquifers underlying the landfills;
- 11 and
- 12 (4) be submitted for independent peer review.
- 13 (c) The commission may work with other state agencies,
- 14 institutions of higher education, nonprofit organizations, private
- 15 organizations, or business entities to conduct the study.
- 16 (d) Not later than January 1, 2017, the commission shall
- 17 submit a report on the results and recommendations of the study to
- 18 the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
- 19 representatives, and the presiding officer of each standing
- 20 committee of the legislature with jurisdiction over environmental
- 21 matters.
- (e) Applications and permits for Type I municipal solid
- 23 waste landfills may not be postponed or delayed pending the results
- 24 of the study.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act expires August 31, 2017.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
