12	cases. Notwithstanding Section 21.013, Property Code, a party
13	initiating a condemnation proceeding in Harris County may file a
14	petition with the district clerk when the amount in controversy
15	exceeds the amount provided by Section 25.0003(c). The amount in
16	controversy is the amount of the bona fide offer made by the entity
17	with eminent domain authority to acquire the property from the
18	property owner voluntarily [regardless of the amount in
19	<pre>controversy].</pre>
20	(d) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, a
21	county civil court at law has jurisdiction to:
22	(1) decide the issue of title to real or personal
23	property;
24	(2) hear a suit to recover damages for slander or

1 defamation of character;

2 (3) hear a suit for the enforcement of a lien on real3 property;

4 (4) hear a suit for the forfeiture of a corporate5 charter;

6 (5) hear a suit for the trial of the right to property 7 valued at \$200 or more that has been levied on under a writ of 8 execution, sequestration, or attachment; and

(6) hear a suit for the recovery of real property.

10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 11 to an eminent domain proceeding for which a petition is filed on or 12 after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain proceeding 13 for which a petition is filed before the effective date of this Act 14 is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and 15 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
