## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the evaluation of the reduction of emissions of air
- 3 contaminants achieved from certain programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 386.205, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 386.205. EVALUATION OF UTILITY COMMISSION AND
- 8 COMPTROLLER ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS. (a) In cooperation with
- 9 the laboratory, the utility commission shall provide an annual
- 10 report to the commission that, by county, quantifies the reductions
- 11 of energy demand, peak loads, and associated emissions of air
- 12 contaminants achieved from programs implemented by the state energy
- 13 conservation office and from programs implemented under Section
- 14 39.905, Utilities Code.
- 15 (b) The report must quantify reductions in the emissions of
- 16 each air contaminant subject to the permitting requirements of
- 17 <u>Chapter 382.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
