- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 141, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 141.0031 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 141.0031. DAYS IN BILLING MONTH. (a) A customer's bill
- 8 may not include charges for a period of more than:
- 9 <u>(1) 32 days for a billing month in which the majority</u>
- 10 of days in the billing month occur in December, January, or
- 11 February; or
- 12 (2) 31 days for a billing month in which the majority
- 13 of days in the billing month occur in any other month.
- 14 (b) If an extreme condition occurs or continues on or after
- 15 the 29th day of a billing month described by Subsection (a)(1), the
- 16 billing month may be extended by the number of days the extreme
- 17 condition occurs. Extreme conditions include:
- 18 <u>(1) iced, flooded, closed, or otherwise impassable</u>
- 19 roads in the county in which the customer resides;
- 20 (2) a natural disaster, including an earthquake, a
- 21 hurricane, a tornado, or winds of more than 60 miles per hour; and
- 22 (3) civil disruption, including war, riot, or labor
- 23 disruption or stoppage.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to a billing month that begins on or after the effective date of
- 2 this Act. A billing month that begins before the effective date of
- 3 this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the billing
- 4 month began, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 5 purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
