A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 1-18 relating to authorizing a student center fee at the University of Houston-Victoria. 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, amended by adding Section 54.5405 to read as follows: 1-20 is 1-21

1-22 1-23 Sec. 54.5405. STUDENT CENTER FEE; UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON-VICTORIA. (a) The board of regents of the University of Houston System may impose on each student enrolled at the 1-24 1-25 University of Houston-Victoria a student center fee to be used only for the purpose of financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, improving, and equipping a student center at the university. A fee imposed under this section is in addition to any 1-26 1-27 1-28 use or service fee authorized to be imposed under other law. 1-29

1-30 (b) The amount of the initial fee imposed under this section 1-31 must be approved by a majority vote of the students enrolled at the university participating in a general student election held 1-32 for 1-33 that purpose.

\$150 per student for each regular semester; (1)

(2) \$100 per student for each summer session of 10 1-37 1-38 weeks or longer; or

(d) Revenue from a fee imposed under this section shall be deposited to the credit of an account known as the "University of Houston-Victoria Student Center Fee Account" under the control of 1-41 1-42 1-43 the university's student fee advisory committee.
