13	commission determines is reliable, shall prepare an annual report
14	on teen pregnancy crisis areas.

16	(1) a list of teen pregnancy crisis areas; and

- 17 (2) a list of zip code areas that were classified as teen pregnancy crisis areas during the previous year, but are no 18 longer teen pregnancy crisis areas. 19
- (d) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission 20 21 shall post the report on the commission's Internet website.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2015, the Health and 22 23 Human Services Commission shall prepare and post on the commission's Internet website the initial report required under 24
