- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

7 SUBCHAPTER D. INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS

- 8 Sec. 32.101. INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS ON UNATTENDED
- 9 CHILDREN IN MOTOR VEHICLES. (a) Using existing resources, the
- 10 department shall develop informational materials that describe the
- 11 danger of leaving a child unattended in a closed motor vehicle
- 12 during hot or sunny weather. The department shall make the
- 13 <u>materials available for download from its Internet website.</u>
- 14 (b) A facility that provides childbirth services shall
- 15 provide a copy of the informational materials described by
- 16 Subsection (a) to a parent or legal guardian of each infant born in
- 17 the facility.
- 18 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2015, the
- 19 Department of State Health Services shall make the informational
- 20 materials required by Section 32.101, Health and Safety Code, as
- 21 added by this Act, available on its Internet website.
- (b) Notwithstanding Section 32.101, Health and Safety Code,
- 23 as added by this Act, a facility is not required to comply with that
- 24 section until January 1, 2016.
