AN ACT

- 2 relating to restrictions on the assessment of the fee charged for
- 3 issuance of certain birth records.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 191.0046, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The state registrar, a local registrar, or a county
- 8 clerk shall issue without fee a certified copy of a birth record to
- 9 an applicant who:

- 10 (1) appears in person to obtain the record; and
- 11 (2) states that the applicant is requesting the record
- 12 for the purpose of obtaining an election identification certificate
- 13 under Section 521A.001, Transportation Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 15 application for a certified copy of a birth record filed on or after
- 16 the effective date of this Act. An application for a certified copy
- 17 of a birth record filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on that date, and the former law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
