4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 311, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter G to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER G. HOSPITAL RAPID RESPONSE SYSTEM
8	Sec. 311.101. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Health care provider" means a person who provides
10	health care services at a hospital as a physician, as an employee of
11	the hospital, or under a contract with the hospital.
12	(2) "Hospital" means:
13	(A) a general or special hospital licensed under
14	Chapter 241 or exempt from licensure under Section 241.004(3); or
15	(B) a private mental hospital licensed under
16	Chapter 577.
17	Sec. 311.102. RAPID RESPONSE SYSTEM REQUIRED. The
18	governing body of a hospital shall adopt, implement, and enforce a
19	policy that prescribes procedures for a health care provider at the
20	hospital to recognize and respond to changes in a patient's
21	condition that is worsening.
22	Sec. 311.103. POLICY REQUIREMENTS. The policy required
23	under Section 311.102 must:
24	(1) provide a method for recognition of and response

1	by a health care provider as soon as possible to a patient's
2	condition if the patient's condition appears to worsen;
3	(2) include written criteria:
4	(A) describing early warning signs that a
5	patient's condition is changing or deteriorating; and
6	(B) establishing the situations in which a health
7	care provider must seek additional assistance for the patient;
8	(3) require a health care provider to seek additional
9	assistance for a patient based on the criteria established by
10	Subdivision (2)(B); and
11	(4) require the hospital to provide instruction to
12	patients and their family members on how to seek assistance from a
13	health care provider if a patient or family member has a concern
14	about changes in the patient's condition.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
