- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 27, Business & Commerce Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 27.015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 27.015. DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE; PUBLIC REMEDY. (a)
- 8 In this section, "consumer protection division" has the meaning
- 9 assigned by Section 17.45.
- 10 (b) A violation of Section 27.01 that relates to the
- 11 transfer of title to real estate is a false, misleading, or
- 12 deceptive act or practice as defined by Section 17.46(b), and any
- 13 public remedy under Subchapter E, Chapter 17, is available for a
- 14 violation of that section.
- 15 (c) It is the duty of city attorneys to lend the consumer
- 16 protection division any reasonable assistance requested in the
- 17 commencement and prosecution of actions under this section.
- 18 <u>(d)</u> To the same extent and in the same manner a district or
- 19 county attorney may institute or prosecute an action under this
- 20 section, a city attorney may institute or prosecute an action under
- 21 this section.
- (e) If a district, county, or city attorney brings an action
- 23 under this section, 75 percent of any penalty recovered shall be
- 24 deposited in the general fund of the county or municipality in which

- 1 the violation occurred.
- 2 <u>(f) This section does not apply to an action to recover</u>
- 3 damages that is subject to Chapter 27, Property Code.
- 4 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 a violation of Section 27.01, Business & Commerce Code, that occurs
- 6 on or after the effective date of this Act. A violation of Section
- 7 27.01, Business & Commerce Code, that occurs before the effective
- 8 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 9 violation occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 10 that purpose. For purposes of this section, a violation occurs
- 11 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the
- 12 violation occurs before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
