A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to municipal control of certain public retirement systems established for the benefit of municipal employees. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 810, Government Code, is amended by 5 adding Section 810.004 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 810.004. MUNICIPAL CONTROL OF RETIREMENT SYSTEM 7 PROVISIONS. (a) In this section, "public retirement system" has 8 9 the meaning assigned by Section 802.001. (b) Except as provided by Sections 66 and 67, Article XVI, 10 Texas Constitution, and notwithstanding any other law, a 11 municipality that is the sponsoring authority of a public 12 retirement system that was created under a state statute, but is not 13 a part of a statewide retirement system, may adopt by ordinance or 14 resolution, as applicable, provisions that supplement or supersede 15 16 the operative provisions of the public retirement system's statute, 17 including any provision relating to the benefits, participation and eligibility requirements, funding source or amount, and 18 19 administration of the system. (c) To the extent of a conflict between a statute adopted 20 before the effective date of the Act enacting this section that 21 applies to a public retirement system described by Subsection (b) 22 23 and a municipal ordinance or resolution adopted by the governing body of the sponsoring municipality of that retirement system under 24

1 this section, the municipal ordinance or resolution prevails.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
