- 3 issued to persons who fail to pay an administrative penalty imposed

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 57, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 57.003 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 57.003. LICENSE SUSPENSION BY STATE AGENCY. (a) For
- 9 purposes of this section, "license," as defined by Section 57.001,
- 10 <u>includes a driver's license.</u>
- 11 (b) A state agency may suspend any license issued by the
- 12 agency to a person who fails to pay an administrative penalty
- 13 <u>imposed under Chapter 651 when due.</u>
- 14 (c) A state agency that receives notice under Section
- 15 651.556(b) shall suspend any license issued by the agency to the
- 16 person who is the subject of the notice until the state agency
- 17 receives notice from the Texas Funeral Service Commission that the
- 18 penalty imposed under Chapter 651 has been paid.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 651.551(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (a) The commission may assess an administrative penalty
- 22 against a person, regardless of whether the person holds a license
- 23 <u>issued</u> [regulated] under this chapter, if the commission determines
- 24 that the person has violated this chapter or a rule adopted under

- 2 SECTION 3. Section 651.556, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 651.556. COLLECTION OF PENALTY. (a) On the
- 5 commission's request, the attorney general shall bring a civil
- 6 action to recover an administrative penalty owed under this
- 7 chapter.
- 8 (b) The commission may, in addition to making a request
- 9 <u>under Subsection (a), establish by rule a procedure to provide</u>
- 10 notice to a state agency that a person owes an administrative
- 11 penalty under this chapter for purposes of Section 57.003.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
