A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the exercise of eminent domain by a toll project entity. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 372, Transportation Code, 4 5 is amended by adding Section 372.002 to read as follows: <u>Sec. 372.002. EMINENT DOMAIN REQUIREMENTS.</u> (a) A toll 6 project entity with eminent domain authority that makes an offer 7 under Section 21.0113, Property Code, must state with specificity 8 9 in the initial and final offers the public use for which the entity 10 intends to acquire the property. 11 (b) A person from whom a real property interest is acquired by a toll project entity for a public purpose through eminent 12 domain, including by purchase after an initial offer under Section 13 21.0113, Property Code, or that person's heirs, successors, or 14 assigns, is entitled to repurchase the property under Subchapter E, 15 16 Chapter 21, Property Code, if the initial use of the property is not the public use for which the property was acquired. 17 (c) Information provided by a toll project entity to a 18 property owner under Section 21.023, Property Code, must also 19 contain information regarding the right to repurchase property as 20 described by Subsection (b). 21 (d) Not later than the 180th day after the date a toll 22 project entity determines that a former property owner is entitled 23 to repurchase the property as described by Subsection (b), the 24

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entity shall send to the property owner or the owner's heirs, 1 successors, or assigns the notice under Section 21.102, Property 2 Code, that contains, in lieu of a statement under Section 3 21.102(2), Property Code, a statement that the initial use of the 4 5 property was not the public use for which the property was acquired. 6 (e) In addition to the requests for information described by Section 21.1021(a), Property Code, a property owner whose property 7 was acquired by a toll project entity by eminent domain or the 8 owner's heirs, successors, or assigns may request that the entity 9 make a determination and provide a statement and other relevant 10 information regarding whether the initial use of the property was 11 12 the public use for which the property was acquired.

13 SECTION 2. Section 372.002, Transportation Code, as added 14 by this Act, applies only to a repurchase of a real property 15 interest condemned or otherwise purchased in connection with an 16 initial offer under Section 21.0113, Property Code, made on or 17 after the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
