- 2 relating to the release of a motor vehicle accident report;
- 3 amending a provision subject to a criminal penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 550.065, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (b), (c), and (d) and adding Subsection
- 7 (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), (c-1), or (e), the
- 9 information is privileged and for the confidential use of:
- 10 (1) the department; and
- 11 (2) an agency of the United States, this state, or a
- 12 local government of this state that has use for the information for
- 13 accident prevention purposes.
- 14 (c) On written request and payment of any required fee, the
- 15 department or the governmental entity shall release the information
- 16 to:
- 17 (1) an entity described by Subsection (b);
- 18 (2) the law enforcement agency that employs the peace
- 19 officer who investigated the accident and sent the information to
- 20 the department;
- 21 (3) the court in which a case involving a person
- 22 involved in the accident is pending if the report is subpoenaed; or
- 23 (4) any $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$ person directly concerned in the accident
- 24 or having a proper interest therein, including [who provides the

1 department or governmental entity with two or more of the following]: 2 3 (A) any person involved in [the date of] the 4 accident; 5 (B) the authorized representative of any person 6 [the specific address or the highway or street where the accident 7 occurred; or 8 [(C) the name of any person] involved in the accident; 9 (C) <u>a driver involved in the accident;</u> 10 (D) an employer, parent, or legal guardian of a 11 12 driver involved in the accident; (E) the owner of a vehicle or property damaged in 13 14 the accident; 15 (F) a person who has established financial 16 responsibility for a vehicle involved in the accident in a manner described by Section 601.051, including a policyholder of a motor 17 vehicle liability insurance policy covering the vehicle; 18 19 (G) an insurance company that issued a motor vehicle liability insurance policy covering a vehicle involved in 20 21 the accident; or 22 (H) any person who may sue because of death resulting from the accident. 23 24 (c-1) On receiving information to which this section applies, the department or the governmental entity that receives 25 26 the information shall create a redacted accident report that may be requested by any person. The redacted accident report may include 27

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- 1 only:
- 2 (1) notwithstanding Subsection (f)(2)(F), the
- 3 <u>location</u>, date, and time of the accident; and
- 4 (2) the make and model of a vehicle involved in the
- 5 accident.
- 6 (d) The fee for a copy of the accident report, including a
- 7 redacted accident report, is \$6. The copy may be certified by the
- 8 department or the governmental entity for an additional fee of
- 9 \$2. The department or the governmental entity may issue a
- 10 certification that no report or information is on file for a fee of
- 11 \$6.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
