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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is 6
- 7 amended by adding Section 403.0306 to read as follows:
- Sec. 403.0306. COST OF CONFINEMENT OR IMPRISONMENT; REQUEST 8
- FOR REIMBURSEMENT. (a) Not later than the 20th day of each month, 9
- the comptroller shall determine the total cost incurred during the 10
- preceding month by the state and each county to confine or imprison 11
- persons who are not lawfully present in the United States. The 12
- comptroller shall obtain this information from the Texas Department 13
- 14 of Criminal Justice and the Commission on Jail Standards.
- (b) Not later than the last day of each month, based on the 15
- information obtained under Subsection (a), the comptroller shall 16
- make a written request to the United States Congress for 17
- reimbursement of the total cost incurred during the preceding month 18
- 19 by the state and each county to confine or imprison persons who are
- not lawfully present in the United States. 20
- 21 (c) The comptroller may adopt rules as necessary to
- implement this section, including rules governing the distribution 22
- 23 to the state and each county of any funds received from the federal
- government for the purpose of reimbursing the state and each county 24

- 1 for the costs of confining or imprisoning persons who are not
- 2 lawfully present in the United States.
- 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Section 493.0152 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 493.0152. COST OF CONFINEMENT OR IMPRISONMENT OF
- 6 PERSONS NOT LAWFULLY PRESENT IN UNITED STATES. Not later than the
- 7 fifth day of each month, the department shall determine the total
- 8 cost incurred during the preceding month by the state, for which
- 9 federal funds have not been received under Section 493.015, to
- 10 confine or imprison in a facility operated by or under contract with
- 11 the department persons who are not lawfully present in the United
- 12 States.
- SECTION 3. Section 511.0101(a), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Each county shall submit to the commission on or before
- 16 the fifth day of each month a report containing the following
- 17 information:
- 18 (1) the number of prisoners confined in the county
- 19 jail on the first day of the month, classified on the basis of the
- 20 following categories:
- 21 (A) total prisoners;
- 22 (B) pretrial Class C misdemeanor offenders;
- (C) pretrial Class A and B misdemeanor offenders;
- 24 (D) convicted misdemeanor offenders;
- 25 (E) felony offenders whose penalty has been
- 26 reduced to a misdemeanor;
- 27 (F) pretrial felony offenders;

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convicted felony offenders; prisoners detained on bench warrants; 2 (H) 3 (I) prisoners detained for parole violations; prisoners detained for federal officers; 4 (J) 5 prisoners awaiting transfer (K) the institutional division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice 6 following conviction of a felony or revocation of probation, 7 8 parole, or release on mandatory supervision and for whom paperwork and processing required for transfer have been completed; 9 10 (L) prisoners detained after having been 11 transferred from another jail and for whom the commission has made a 12 payment under Subchapter F, Chapter 499, Government Code; prisoners $\underline{\text{who}}$ are not lawfully present in the 13 14 United States [for whom an immigration detainer has been issued by 15 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement]; and (N) other prisoners; 16 17 (2) the total capacity of the county jail on the first day of the month; 18 the total number of prisoners who were confined in 19 (3) the county jail during the preceding month, based on a count 20 conducted on each day of that month, who were known or had been 21 determined to be pregnant; 22 23 (4) the total cost to the county during the preceding 24 month of housing prisoners described by Subdivision (1)(M), calculated based on the average daily cost of housing a prisoner in 25 26 the county jail; and 27 (5) certification by the reporting official that the

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- 1 information in the report is accurate.
- 2 SECTION 4. The comptroller of public accounts of the State
- 3 of Texas shall make the first determination required by Section
- 4 403.0306, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 5 October 20, 2015, and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice
- 6 shall make the first determination required by Section 493.0152,
- 7 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than October 5,
- 8 2015.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
