## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to day care assistance and to requiring the Department of
- 3 Family and Protective Services to study the effectiveness of the
- 4 relative and other designated caregiver program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 264.761 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 264.761. STUDY OF PROGRAM. (a) The department shall
- 9 study the effectiveness of the relative and other designated
- 10 caregiver placement program created by this subchapter and make
- 11 recommendations on improvements to the program. Any such
- 12 improvements should be designed to minimize the number of
- 13 placements for each child, maximize efficiency in distribution of
- 14 any monetary or other assistance for which caregivers qualify,
- 15 facilitate safe and permanent exit from the managing
- 16 conservatorship of the department in as timely a fashion as
- 17 possible, and prepare caregivers for verification necessary to
- 18 receive for foster care maintenance reimbursement. The
- 19 recommendations may include increases to the dollar amount of
- 20 assistance as well as the identification of automated or other
- 21 processes designed to speed the payment of assistance.
- 22 (b) The department shall report its findings and
- 23 recommendations to the legislature not later than January 1, 2017.
- 24 (c) This section expires September 1, 2017.
