4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 43.05(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) A capias pro fine authorizes a peace officer to place
8	the defendant in jail until the business day following the date of
9	the defendant's arrest if the defendant cannot be brought before
10	the court immediately. <u>Instead of placing the defendant in jail as</u>
11	authorized by this subsection, the peace officer may bring the
12	defendant before another court that is in the same territorial
13	jurisdiction as, and that has concurrent jurisdiction with, the
14	court that issued the capias pro fine.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
