- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, 6 is amended by adding Section 33.021 to read as follows:
- Sec. 33.021. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN RESOURCES IN DETERMINING

  8 SNAP ELIGIBILITY. In determining the eligibility of an applicant

  9 for or recertifying the eligibility of a recipient of supplemental
- 10 nutrition assistance benefits, the department may not consider as
- 11 resources:

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- (1) any liquid resources of the applicant or recipient
- or a member of the applicant's or recipient's household; or
- 14 (2) any motor vehicle in which the applicant or
- 15 recipient or a member of the applicant's or recipient's household
- 16 has an ownership interest.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 18 initial determination or recertification of eligibility of a person
- 19 for the supplemental nutrition assistance program under Chapter 33,
- 20 Human Resources Code, that is made on or after the effective date of
- 21 this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 23 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 24 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

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- 1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 3 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
