## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 481.062, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c)</u> A chemical manufacturer engaged in commercial research
- 9 and development pursuant to a designation issued under 6 C.F.R.
- 10 Part 25 is not required to register under this chapter.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
