17	(j) In [contain, in] addition to any other statements
18	required under this section, notice served on a debtor under this

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boldface or underlined type, and substantially similar to the

following: "Assert and protect your rights as a member of the

armed forces of the United States. If you are or your spouse is

serving on active military duty, including active military duty as

a member of the Texas National Guard or the National Guard of

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- 1 another state or as a member of a reserve component of the armed
- 2 forces of the United States, please send written notice of the
- 3 active duty military service to the sender of this notice

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 51.002(i), Property Code, as amended by
- 6 this Act, applies only to a notice of sale given on or after the
- 7 effective date of this Act. A notice of sale given before the
- 8 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed when
- 9 the notice was given, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 10 that purpose.
