8 SECTION 3. This Act shall be construed, as a matter of state law, to be enforceable up to but no further than the maximum 9 consistent with federal constitutional 10 possible extent requirements, even if that construction is not readily apparent, 11 and such constructions are authorized only to the extent necessary 12 to save the statute from judicial invalidation. 13

14 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 16 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 18 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 19 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 21
