## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the reporting of physical assaults against certain
3	direct care personnel.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 4, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 258A to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 258A. REPORTING ASSAULTS AGAINST DIRECT CARE PERSONNEL
8	Sec. 258A.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Department" means the Department of State Health
10	Services.
11	(2) "Direct care personnel" means individuals who:
12	(A) provide health care services to patients in a
13	health care facility; or
14	(B) provide home health, hospice, or personal
15	assistance as an employee of or under contract with a home and
16	community support agency.
17	(3) "Health care facility" means a facility that
18	provides health care services to patients and includes:
19	(A) a facility licensed under this subtitle,
20	including a hospital or nursing home;
21	(B) a private mental hospital licensed under
22	Chapter 577; or
23	(C) a hospital that is maintained or operated by
24	the state.

- 1 (4) "Home and community support agency" means an
- 2 agency licensed under Chapter 142.
- 3 (5) "Physical assault" means conduct constituting an
- 4 offense under Section 22.01, Penal Code.
- 5 Sec. 258A.002. POLICY. (a) Each health care facility or
- 6 home and community support agency shall adopt and implement a
- 7 policy under which direct care personnel report to the facility or
- 8 agency any incidents of physical assault.
- 9 (b) A policy adopted under this section must require the
- 10 reporting of:
- 11 (1) the job title of the direct care personnel
- 12 assaulted;
- 13 (2) the type of assault;
- 14 (3) the extent of the injury to the direct care
- 15 personnel;
- 16 (4) the location where the assault occurred, including
- 17 any specific department or area of a health care facility; and
- 18 (5) whether the person who engaged in the physical
- 19 assault was a patient, client, or resident, a family member, or
- 20 another staf<u>f member.</u>
- Sec. 258A.003. REPORTING. (a) Each health care facility or
- 22 home and community support agency shall annually report
- 23 <u>de-identified aggregate data to the department on the incidents of</u>
- 24 physical assault against direct care personnel that were reported
- 25 to the facility or agency by direct care personnel.
- 26 (b) The report to the department may not contain any
- 27 information that could personally identify the person who engaged

- 1 in the physical assault, a victim of the assault, or a facility at
- 2 which an assault occurred.
- 3 (c) The department may coordinate the reporting under this
- 4 section with other required reports made to the department under
- 5 <u>other law.</u>
- 6 (d) De-identified aggregate data reported under this
- 7 section is public information subject to Chapter 552, Government
- 8 Code.
- 9 Sec. 258A.004. HEALTH PROFESSIONS RESOURCE CENTER. (a) The
- 10 department, after reviewing the data reported to the department
- 11 under this chapter to ensure that personal identifying information
- 12 is not included, shall make the data available to the health
- 13 professions resource center established under Chapter 105.
- 14 (b) The health professions resource center shall prepare an
- 15 annual report based on the data supplied by the department under
- 16 this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) A facility or agency subject to Section
- 18 258A.002, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, shall adopt
- 19 the policy required by that section not later than January 1, 2016.
- 20 (b) A facility or agency required to make a report under
- 21 Section 258A.003, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, is
- 22 not required to make an annual report to the Department of State
- 23 Health Services before March 1, 2017. The Department of State
- 24 Health Services shall set the date of the initial report for not
- 25 later than March 1, 2018, and may set the date of the initial report
- 26 to coordinate with other reports as provided by Section
- 27 258A.003(c), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.

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1 (c) The health professions resource center is not required
2 to prepare the initial annual report under Section 258A.004(b),
3 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, before the 120th day
4 after the date the center receives access to the relevant data.
5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
