- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.037, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as

- 8 (a) A person may not use [commits an offense if the person or
- 9 the person's servant or agent knowingly uses] an incorrect weighing
- 10 or measuring device in:
- 11 (1) buying or selling a commodity;
- 12 (2) computing a charge for services rendered on the

- 14 (3) determining the weight or measure of a commodity,
- 15 if a charge is made for the determination.
- 16 <u>(c) A person commits an offense if the person or the</u>
- 17 person's servant or agent knowingly violates Subsection (a).
- SECTION 2. Section 13.120, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 19 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 (b) A person may not [commits an offense if the person or the
- 22 person's servant or agent knowingly]:
- 23 (1) offer [offers] or expose [exposes] for sale, hire,
- 24 or award or sell [sells] an incorrect weighing or measuring device;

- 1 (2) <u>possesses</u>] an incorrect weighing or
- 2 measuring device; or
- 3 (3) <u>sell, offer for sale, use, or possess</u> [sells,
- 4 offers for sale, uses, or possesses] for the purpose of sale or use
- 5 a device or instrument to be used to falsify or intended to falsify
- 6 a weight or measure.
- 7 <u>(c) A person commits an offense if the person or the</u>
- 8 person's servant or agent knowingly violates Subsection (b).
- 9 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 an offense committed or conduct that occurs on or after the
- 11 effective date of this Act. An offense committed or conduct that
- 12 occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 13 in effect on the date the offense was committed or the conduct
- 14 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 15 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed or
- 16 conduct occurs before the effective date of this Act if any element
- 17 of the offense or conduct occurs before the effective date.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
