1 or intended to falsify a weight or measure.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 2 an offense committed or conduct that occurs on or after the 3 4 effective date of this Act. An offense committed or conduct that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 5 6 in effect on the date the offense was committed or the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that 7 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed or 8 conduct occurs before the effective date of this Act if any element 9 of the offense or conduct occurs before the effective date. 10
