- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.037(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if the person or the
- 8 person's servant or agent [knowingly] uses an incorrect weighing or
- 9 measuring device in:
- 10 (1) buying or selling a commodity;
- 11 (2) computing a charge for services rendered on the
- 12 basis of weight or measure; or
- 13 (3) determining the weight or measure of a commodity,
- 14 if a charge is made for the determination.
- SECTION 2. Section 13.120(b), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (b) A person commits an offense if the person or the
- 18 person's servant or agent [knowingly]:
- 19 (1) offers or exposes for sale, hire, or award or sells
- 20 an incorrect weighing or measuring device;
- 21 (2) possesses an incorrect weighing or measuring
- 22 device; or
- 23 (3) sells, offers for sale, uses, or possesses for the
- 24 purpose of sale or use a device or instrument to be used to falsify

- 1 or intended to falsify a weight or measure.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an offense committed or conduct that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed or conduct that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed or the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 8 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed or
- 9 conduct occurs before the effective date of this Act if any element
- 10 of the offense or conduct occurs before the effective date.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
