4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 521.205(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The department by rule shall provide for approval of a
8	driver education course conducted by the parent, stepparent, foster
9	parent, legal guardian, step-grandparent, or grandparent of a
10	person who is required to complete a driver education course to
11	obtain a Class C license. The rules must provide that:
12	(1) the person conducting the course possess a valid
13	license for the preceding three years that has not been suspended,
14	revoked, or forfeited in the past three years for an offense that
15	involves the operation of a motor vehicle;
16	(2) the student driver spend a minimum number of hours
17	in:
18	(A) classroom instruction; and
19	(B) behind-the-wheel instruction;
20	(3) the person conducting the course not be convicted
21	of:
22	(A) criminally negligent homicide; or
23	(B) driving while intoxicated; and
24	(4) [the person conducting the course not be disabled

l because of mental illness; and

- 2 $\left[\frac{(5)}{}\right]$ the person conducting the course not have six or
- 3 more points assigned to the person's driver's license under
- 4 Subchapter B, Chapter 708, at the time the person begins conducting
- 5 the course.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
