(a) If a statute that 8 establishes a multicounty statutory county court does not designate 9 one of the counties that compose the multicounty statutory county 10 court as the administrative county for that court, the county with 11 the greatest population of the counties composing the court at the 12 time the court is established is the administrative county for that 13 14 court. (b) The commissioners courts of the counties that compose a 15 16 multicounty statutory county court may enter into an agreement to provide support for the court. The administrative county for the 17 court may receive contributions from the other counties composing 18 the court to pay the operating expenses of the court. 19 20 (c) Except for money provided by state appropriations or under an agreement under Subsection (b), the administrative county 21 shall pay out of the county's general fund the salaries, 22 23 compensation, and expenses incurred in operating the multicounty 24 statutory county court.

1 (d) Notwithstanding Section 25.0015, the state shall 2 annually compensate the administrative county of a multicounty 3 statutory county court in an amount equal to 100 percent of the 4 state salary of a district court judge in the county for the salary 5 of the judge of the multicounty statutory county court.

6 (e) The court fees and costs collected by the clerk of a 7 multicounty statutory county court shall be deposited in the 8 appropriate county fund as provided by law.

9 SECTION 2. Section 25.2701, Government Code, is amended to 10 read as follows:

11 Sec. 25.2701. 1ST MULTICOUNTY COURT AT LAW (FISHER[, 12 MITCHELL,] AND NOLAN COUNTIES). Fisher[, Mitchell,] and Nolan 13 Counties have a multicounty statutory county court composed of 14 those counties, the 1st Multicounty Court at Law.

15 SECTION 3. Section 25.2702, Government Code, is amended by 16 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

17 (c-1) Nolan County is the administrative county for the 1st
18 <u>Multicounty Court at Law.</u>

19 SECTION 4. Section 25.2702(g), Government Code, is 20 repealed.

SECTION 5. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
