- 7 person is disqualified to serve as a petit juror unless the person:
- 8 (1) is at least 18 years of age;
- 9 (2) <u>is a citizen of the United States;</u>
- 10 (3) is a resident [citizen] of this state and of the
- 11 county in which the person is to serve as a juror;
- 12 $\underline{(4)}$ [(3)] is qualified under the constitution and laws
- 13 to vote in the county in which the person is to serve as a juror;
- 14 (5) [(4)] is of sound mind and good moral character;
- (6) $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ is able to read and write;
- 16 (7) [(6)] has not served as a petit juror for six days
- 17 during the preceding three months in the county court or during the
- 18 preceding six months in the district court;
- 19 (8) (47) has not been convicted of misdemeanor theft
- 20 or a felony; and
- 21 (9) [(8)] is not under indictment or other legal
- 22 accusation for misdemeanor theft or a felony.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
