1-20 relating to qualifications to serve as a petit juror.  
 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-22 SECTION 1. Section 62.102, Government Code, is amended to  
 1-23 read as follows:  
 1-24 Sec. 62.102. GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE. A  
 1-25 person is disqualified to serve as a petit juror unless the person:  
 1-26 (1) is at least 18 years of age;  
 1-27 (2) is a citizen of the United States;  
 1-28 (3) is a resident [~~citizen~~] of this state and of the  
 1-29 county in which the person is to serve as a juror;  
 1-30 (4) [~~(3)~~] is qualified under the constitution and laws  
 1-31 to vote in the county in which the person is to serve as a juror;  
 1-32 (5) [~~(4)~~] is of sound mind and good moral character;  
 1-33 (6) [~~(5)~~] is able to read and write;  
 1-34 (7) [~~(6)~~] has not served as a petit juror for six days  
 1-35 during the preceding three months in the county court or during the  
 1-36 preceding six months in the district court;  
 1-37 (8) [~~(7)~~] has not been convicted of misdemeanor theft  
 1-38 or a felony; and  
 1-39 (9) [~~(8)~~] is not under indictment or other legal  
 1-40 accusation for misdemeanor theft or a felony.  
 1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
