A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a petition filed in connection with an application for a  
3 place on the ballot.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 141.065, Election Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) A single notarized affidavit by any person who obtained  
8 signatures is valid for all signatures gathered by the person if the  
9 date of notarization is on or after the date of the last signature  
10 obtained by the person.

11 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 141, Election Code, is  
12 amended by adding Section 141.071 to read as follows:

13 Sec. 141.071. CORRECTION OF PETITION. A petition may be  
14 corrected and additional signatures presented to the appropriate  
15 authority after it has been initially filed but not after the  
16 deadline for filing the petition.

17 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a  
18 petition circulated on or after the effective date of this Act. A  
19 petition circulated before the effective date of this Act is  
20 governed by the law in effect on the date the petition is  
21 circulated, and the former law is continued in effect for that  
22 purpose.

23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
