2	relating to the enforcement of traffic laws by local authorities.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 707, Transportation Code,
5	is amended to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 707. PHOTOGRAPHIC TRAFFIC SIGNAL
7	ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM PROHIBITED
8	SECTION 2. Sections 707.001(3) and (4), Transportation
9	Code, are amended to read as follows:
10	(3) "Photographic traffic signal enforcement system"
11	means a <u>device or</u> system that[+

13	(A) a camera system and vehicle sensor that are:
14	(i) installed to exclusively work in
15	conjunction with an electrically operated traffic-control signal;

18	least two] recorded images that depict the <u>operator of a motor</u>
19	vehicle, or the license plate attached to the front or the rear of
20	the $[a]$ motor vehicle, that is not operated in compliance with the
21	instructions of the traffic-control signal; or
22	(B) a radar unit or sensor linked to:
23	(i) a camera or other recording device that
24	is capable of producing a photograph, microphotograph, videotape,

- 1 or other recorded image of the operator or license plate of a motor
- 2 vehicle; or
- 3 <u>(ii)</u> a device that is capable of reading a
- 4 license plate attached to a motor vehicle or otherwise identifying
- 5 a motor vehicle.
- 6 (4) "Recorded image" means a photographic or digital
- 7 image that depicts the front or the rear of a motor vehicle or the
- 8 operator of a motor vehicle.
- 9 SECTION 3. Chapter 707, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 10 adding Sections 707.020 and 707.021 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 707.020. USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC TRAFFIC SIGNAL
- 12 ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other law, the
- 13 state or a political subdivision of the state may not issue a civil
- 14 or criminal charge or citation for an offense or violation based on
- 15 <u>a recorded image produced by a photographic traffic signal</u>
- 16 <u>enforcement system.</u>
- Sec. 707.021. COSTS OF CHARGE OR CITATION. If the state or
- 18 any political subdivision of the state violates Section 707.020,
- 19 the entity that commits the violation is responsible for all costs
- 20 incurred by the owner or operator of a motor vehicle who was charged
- 21 or received the citation, including reasonable attorney's fees.
- SECTION 4. Section 27.031(a), Government Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) In addition to the jurisdiction and powers provided by
- 25 the constitution and other law, the justice court has original
- 26 jurisdiction of:
- 27 (1) civil matters in which exclusive jurisdiction is

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- 1 not in the district or county court and in which the amount in
- 2 controversy is not more than \$10,000, exclusive of interest;
- 3 (2) cases of forcible entry and detainer; and
- 4 (3) foreclosure of mortgages and enforcement of liens
- 5 on personal property in cases in which the amount in controversy is
- 6 otherwise within the justice court's jurisdiction[; and
- 7 [(4) cases arising under Chapter 707, Transportation
- 8 Code, outside a municipality's territorial limits].
- 9 SECTION 5. Section 133.004, Local Government Code, as
- 10 amended by Chapters 718 (H.B. 2359), 1027 (H.B. 1623), and 1149
- 11 (S.B. 1119), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007,
- 12 is reenacted and amended to read as follows:

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- 1 SECTION 7. (a) The repeal by this Act of Sections 542.405 and 542.406, Transportation Code, and provisions of Chapter 707, 2 3 Transportation Code, does not affect the validity of a proceeding initiated or a civil penalty imposed under those provisions before 4 5 the effective date of this Act. A proceeding initiated or a civil penalty imposed under those provisions before the effective date of 6 this Act is governed by the applicable law in effect before the 7 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in 8 effect for that purpose. 9
- 10 Notwithstanding the repeal by this Act of Sections 542.405 and 542.406, Transportation Code, and provisions of Chapter 11 12 707, Transportation Code, if before June 1, 2015, a local authority had enacted an ordinance under those provisions to implement a 13 14 photographic traffic signal enforcement system and entered into a 15 contract for the administration and enforcement of the system, the local authority may continue to operate the system under that 16 17 ordinance and under the terms of that contract until the expiration date specified in the contract as the contract existed on June 1, 18 2015. 19
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
