1-21 relating to trauma-informed care training for certain employees of
 1-22 state supported living centers and intermediate care facilities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 161, Human Resources Code,
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 161.088 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 161.088. TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE TRAINING. (a) The
 1-27 department shall develop or adopt trauma-informed care training for
 1-28 employees who work directly with individuals with intellectual and
 1-29 developmental disabilities in state supported living centers and
 1-30 intermediate care facilities. The executive commissioner by rule
 1-31 shall require new employees to complete the training before working
 1-32 with individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

1-33 (b) The training required under this section may be provided
 1-34 through an Internet website.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
