- 1 total expenses incurred by the political party in holding primary
- 2 elections in the county that year, exclusive of the [combined]

- 4 personnel, money spent for rental payments, including polling place
- 5 rental, and money spent for expenses related to furniture or
- 6 utilities. The resulting compensation under subsection (2) and (3)
