## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to home-school education for foster children.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 263, Family Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 263.0045 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 263.0045. EDUCATION IN HOME SETTING FOR FOSTER
- 7 CHILDREN. On request of a person providing substitute care for a
- 8 child who is in the managing conservatorship of the department, the
- 9 department shall allow the person to provide the child with an
- 10 education in a home setting unless:
- 11 (1) the right of the department to allow the education
- 12 of the child in a home setting has been specifically limited by
- 13 court order;
- 14 (2) a court at a hearing conducted under this chapter
- 15 finds, on good cause shown through evidence presented by the
- 16 department in accordance with the applicable provisions in the
- 17 department's child protective services handbook (CPS August 2013),
- 18 that education in the home setting is not in the best interest of
- 19 the child; or
- 20 (3) the department determines that federal law
- 21 requires another school setting.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
