## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to permissible teachers assigned to a bilingual education
- 3 program and the permissible uses of the bilingual education
- 4 allotment provided under the foundation school program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 29.061, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-3) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-3), a [A] teacher
- 10 assigned to a bilingual education program must be appropriately
- 11 certified for bilingual education by the board.
- 12 (b-3) A school district may assign to a bilingual education
- 13 program a teacher certified for English as a second language for a
- 14 school year if:
- 15 (1) the commissioner has determined that there is a
- 16 shortage of teachers certified for bilingual education by the board
- 17 for the school year; and
- 18 (2) a teacher certified for bilingual education is not
- 19 reasonably available to the district.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.153(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (c) A district's bilingual education or special language
- 23 allocation may be used only for program and student evaluation,
- 24 instructional materials and equipment, staff development,

- 1 supplemental staff expenses, salary [supplements] for teachers,
- 2 and other supplies required for quality instruction and smaller
- 3 class size.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
