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(ii) a county that is included in an emergency disaster proclamation issued by the governor.

Mexico at a point located in this state; and

4 SECTION 2. (a) This Act applies only to an application for 5 a water right or an amendment to a permit, certified filing, or 6 certificate of adjudication authorizing an interbasin transfer of 7 water that is accepted for filing on or after the effective date of 8 this Act.

9 (b) An application for a water right or an amendment to a 10 permit, certified filing, or certificate of adjudication 11 authorizing an interbasin transfer of water that is accepted for 12 filing before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 13 in effect at the time the application is accepted for filing, and 14 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
