5	SECTION 1. Section 31.002, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subdivision (1-b) to read as follows:
7	(1-b) "Proclamation" means a request for production of
8	new instructional materials issued by the State Board of Education.
9	SECTION 2. Section 31.022, Education Code, is amended by
10	adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (f) to read as
11	follows:
12	(b-1) For any biennium, the board may only issue
13	proclamations for instructional materials in which the total
14	projected cost of instructional materials under the proclamations
15	does not exceed 75 percent of the total amount used to fund the
16	instructional materials allotment under Section 31.0211 for that
17	biennium.
18	(f) The board shall amend any <u>proclamation</u> [request for
19	production] issued for the purchase of instructional materials to
20	conform to the instructional materials funding levels provided by
21	the General Appropriations Act for the year of implementation <u>and</u>
22	to comply with Subsection (b-1).
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
