- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 164, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 164.0525 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 164.0525. INQUIRY INTO GUN OWNERSHIP PROHIBITED. (a)
- 8 In this section, "patient" has the meaning provided by Section
- 9 159.001.
- 10 (b) A physician, other than a psychiatrist, may not:
- 11 (1) inquire into, or ask a patient to disclose,
- 12 whether a firearm is located or stored on property owned by or under
- 13 the patient's control, including the patient's home; and
- 14 (2) require that information described by Subdivision
- 15 (1) be disclosed before providing treatment to the patient.
- 16 (c) The board may take disciplinary action against a
- 17 physician who violates Subsection (b).
- SECTION 2. Section 164.0525, Occupations Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to conduct that occurs on or after the
- 20 effective date of this Act. Conduct that occurs before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 22 date the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
