 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the definition of homeland security activity.  
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 421.001(3), Government Code, is amended  
 1-22 to read as follows:  
 1-23 (3) "Homeland security activity" means any activity  
 1-24 related to the prevention or discovery of, response to, or recovery  
 1-25 from:  
 1-26 (A) a terrorist attack; ~~[ ]~~  
 1-27 (B) a natural or man-made disaster; ~~[ ]~~  
 1-28 (C) a hostile military or paramilitary action; ~~[ ]~~  
 1-29 ~~or~~  
 1-30 (D) an extraordinary law enforcement emergency;  
 1-31 or  
 1-32 (E) a fire or medical emergency requiring  
 1-33 resources beyond the capabilities of a local jurisdiction.  
 1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
