5	SECTION 1. Section 552.221, Government Code, is amended by

 9 Subsection (a) by referring a requestor to a website maintained by
 10 the governmental body and accessible to the public if the requested
 11 information is identifiable and readily available on that website.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 552, Government Code, is 13 amended by adding Section 552.233 to read as follows:
- 14 <u>Sec. 552.233. RESPONDING TO REQUESTS FOR COPYRIGHTED</u>
 15 <u>INFORMATION.</u> (a) An officer for public information complies with
 16 <u>Section 552.221(a)</u> by producing for inspection requested
 17 information that is protected by copyright law.
- 18 <u>(b) An officer for public information is not required to</u>
 19 <u>furnish copies of copyrighted information and may refuse to furnish</u>
 20 <u>such copies without the necessity of requesting a decision from the</u>
 21 <u>attorney general under Subchapter G.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 182.052, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) A governmental body as defined by Section 552.003,

- 1 Government Code, may withhold information prohibited from being
- 2 disclosed under this section without the necessity of requesting a
- 3 decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G, Chapter 552,
- 4 Government Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 7 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 8 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 9 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 10 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 11 effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
