14	(a-1) Each school district that offers prekindergarten
15	classes under Section 29.153 shall develop a system to notify the
16	population in the district with children of prekindergarten age who
17	are not eligible for enrollment in prekindergarten classes under
18	Section 29.153 of the availability of prekindergarten classes. The
19	district shall offer prekindergarten classes under this subsection
20	using district funds or on a tuition basis. The district shall
21	<pre>offer:</pre>
22	(1) half-day classes if the classes for children
23	eligible under Section 29.153 are half-day classes; or

(2) full-day classes if the classes for children

- 1 eligible under Section 29.153 are full-day classes.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
