(2) present proof to the board that the assistant has:
(A) graduated from a dental assisting program
accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the
American Dental Association and approved by the board that includes
specific didactic course work and clinical training in coronal
polishing; or

8 (B) received certification of completion of 9 requirements specified by the Dental Assisting National Board and 10 approved by the board.

11 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 12 of this Act, the State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt rules 13 necessary to implement Section 265.006(b), Occupations Code, as 14 amended by this Act.
