- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 63.0101, Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 63.0101. DOCUMENTATION OF PROOF OF
- 7 IDENTIFICATION. The following documentation is an acceptable form
- 8 of photo identification under this chapter:
- 9 (1) a driver's license, election identification
- 10 certificate, or personal identification card issued to the person
- 11 by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or that
- 12 expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of presentation;
- 13 (2) a United States military identification card that
- 14 contains the person's photograph that has not expired or that
- 15 expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of presentation;
- 16 (3) a United States citizenship certificate issued to
- 17 the person that contains the person's photograph;
- 18 (4) a United States passport issued to the person that
- 19 has not expired or that expired no earlier than 60 days before the
- 20 date of presentation; [<del>or</del>]
- 21 (5) a license to carry a concealed handgun issued to
- 22 the person by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired
- 23 or that expired no earlier than 60 days before the date of

- (6) a student identification card issued by a high

  school located in the state or an institution of higher education or

  a private or independent institution of higher education as those

  terms are defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, that:

  (A) contains the person's photograph; and

  (B) is accompanied by proof of current enrollment

  issued by the high school or institution.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
