| 6 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 7 | SECTION 1. Chapter 623, Transportation Code, is amended by |
| 8 | adding Subchapter T to read as follows: |
| 9 | SUBCHAPTER T. WEBB COUNTY PERMITS |
| 10 | Sec. 623.381. OPTIONAL PROCEDURE. This subchapter provides |
| 11 | an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit by the City of |
| 12 | Laredo for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles carrying |
| 13 | cargo on certain roads located in Webb County. |
| 14 | Sec. 623.382. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS. The commission may |
| 15 | authorize the City of Laredo to issue permits for the movement of |
| 16 | oversize or overweight vehicles carrying cargo in Webb County on: |
| 17 | (1) the following roads: |
| 18 | (A) State Highway Loop 20 between its |
| 19 | intersection with the World Trade Bridge and its intersection with |
| 20 | Farm-to-Market Road 1472; |
| 21 | (B) Farm-to-Market Road 1472 between its |
| 22 | intersection with State Highway Loop 20 and the northernmost of its |
| 23 | intersections with World Trade Center Loop; |
| 24 | (C) Farm-to-Market Road 1472 between the |
| | |

- 1 northernmost of its intersections with World Trade Center Loop and
- 2 its intersection with Hachar Loop, if the Hachar Loop project in the
- 3 city of Laredo is constructed;
- 4 (D) Hachar Loop between its intersection with
- 5 Farm-to-Market Road 1472 and its intersection with Beltway Parkway,
- 6 if the Hachar Loop project in the city of Laredo is constructed; and
- 7 (E) Beltway Parkway between its intersection
- 8 with Hachar Loop and its intersection with Interstate Highway 35,
- 9 if the Hachar Loop project in the city of Laredo is constructed; or
- 10 (2) another route designated by the commission in
- 11 consultation with the city.
- 12 Sec. 623.383. PERMIT FEES. (a) The City of Laredo may
- 13 collect a fee for permits issued under this subchapter. Beginning
- 14 September 1, 2015, the maximum amount of the fee may not exceed \$200
- 15 per trip. On September 1 of each subsequent year, the city may
- 16 <u>adjust the maximum fee amount as necessary to reflect the</u>
- 17 percentage change during the preceding year in the Consumer Price
- 18 Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. City Average, published
- 19 monthly by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics or its
- 20 successor in function.
- (b) Fees collected under Subsection (a) shall be used only
- 22 for the operation and maintenance of the roads described by or
- 23 <u>designated under Section 623.382</u>. The City of Laredo shall make
- 24 payments to the Texas Department of Transportation to provide funds
- 25 for the operation and maintenance of roads and highways subject to
- 26 this subchapter.
- 27 <u>Sec. 623.384. PERMIT REQUIREMENTS.</u> (a) A permit issued

1 under this subchapter must include: 2 (1) the name of the applicant; 3 (2) the date of issuance; 4 (3) the signature of the designated agent for the City 5 of Laredo; 6 (4) a statement of the kind of cargo being 7 transported, the maximum weight and dimensions of the equipment, 8 and the kind and weight of each commodity to be transported; 9 (5) a statement: 10 (A) that the gross weight of the vehicle for 11 which a permit is issued may not exceed 125,000 pounds; and 12 (B) of any other condition on which the permit is 13 issued; 14 (6) a statement that the cargo may be transported in 15 Webb County only over the roads described by or designated under Section 623.382; and 16 17 (7) the location where the cargo was loaded. The City of Laredo shall report to the department all 18 19 permits issued under this subchapter. Sec. 623.385. TIME OF MOVEMENT. A permit issued under this 20 subchapter must specify the time during which movement authorized 21 by the permit is allowed. 22 Sec. 623.386. SPEED LIMIT. Movement authorized by a permit 23 24 issued under this subchapter may not exceed the posted speed limit

Sec. 623.387. ENFORCEMENT. The Department of Public Safety

or 55 miles per hour, whichever is less. A violation of this

provision constitutes a moving violation.
